

Should you be refused entry we will always offer to phone your parent/guardian.

If staff have concerns over your safety and you do not co-operate with them calling parents, we will contact police or other relevant agencies.

We encourage you to get dropped off and picked up if possible, if not stick with your friends.

ClubZone+ events will welcome a police presence in and around the venues. They will work with youth workers, CCTV operators and other relevant agencies who are interested in your well-being. Clubs will need to maintain good practice if they want to remain part of ClubZone+.

You are encouraged to e-mail clubzone6vt@aol.com and state if you are happy or unhappy with the ClubZone+ service you are receiving. 6VT Youth Cafe will feed it back direct to the clubs.

Wise up on personal safety.....

Let someone know where you are and when you will be home. Be alert at all times!

If you are feeling afraid of someone - lose them. If you are in trouble go to a public place and ask for help or call 999

Clubbing clothes look good but they may leave you vulnerable out in the street. Sadly there are people who may target you because of what you're wearing. Cover up to and from the club.

Can you run in your fashion shoes? If not bring a spare pair. THINK SAFETY

Use cloakrooms - thefts happen when people leave belongings lying about the club.

All venues operate a cloakroom for a small fee - losing your mobile could cost you £50 to replace, weigh it up - £1? or £50?

You know it makes sense!

Out in the street, don't flash your valuables.

Make sure your mobile is charged up and you have credit.

Positively promoting safe under 18's night clubs

C h a r t e r

Under 18's club promoters have got together to help you have as safe and enjoyable a night out as possible. We have put together this charter so that you know what to expect from us. The Police think its a 'sound' idea and support it getting put into action. We look forward to your co-operation. All clubs who sign up to ClubZone+ will work to the same guidelines - Remember this is all to improve your safety.

ClubZone+ events will have door staff who are licensed and registered with their local Council. There will always be a qualified first aider working in the venue. Each club will have a minimum of two staff in the premises who have gone through a special check to ensure they are suitable adults to be responsible for young people. (Disclosure Scotland Checked) Staff will accompany unauthorised adults visiting the club at all times. e.g. Mums or Dads looking for their kids!!!

ClubZone+ events are strictly for under 18's. They are aimed at 14-17 year olds. You may be asked to show I.D.

Once in the club there will be no exit until you are leaving.

If you are feeling unsafe or threatened in a club please speak to staff so that something can be done about it.

Zero tolerance to alcohol, drugs and weapons. Club staff may search you. They may ask you to take a breath test or scan you with a metal detector.

If you refuse - staff can refuse you entry!

If a club has CCTV, it will be in operation.

Smoke-free zones will be provided in all venues.

Zero tolerance to chewing gum! - might seem strange but it really messes up the floors!
